- 1) YCC1112 Literature and Humanities 2
- 2) YCC1114 Philosophy and Political Thought 2
- 3) YCC1131 Scientific Inquiry 1

→ Please select Group A or Group B timing from system; Registry will allocate you to the specific group number (Group 1 to 14) for the Common Curriculum modules in Round 3.

→ Do note that although you are given the option to select your preferred timings for your Common Curriculum seminars, you may be re-allocated to another timing if the timing that you have selected becomes over-subscribed.

- **Recommended number of MCs per semester:** 20MCs
- **Minimum number of MCs per semester:** 18MCs
- **Maximum number of MCs per semester:** 22MCs
  
- **Overload** = doing more than 22MCs in a semester
- **Underload** = doing less than 18MCs in a semester
- You will need the Assistant Dean's approval if you wish to overload/underload by filling out the [Overload/Underload Form](#)

## Pre-requisites:

- **Pre-requisite for Yale-NUS modules:** If you do not meet the pre-requisite but have gotten instructor's permission to waive it off, please forward Registry the email approval from instructor so we can waive the pre-requisite in system for you to select the module
- **Pre-requisite for high school equivalent modules:** If you have taken a similar module back in high school as the pre-requisite but unable to register, please email Registry for assistance (Example: YSS2203 Intermediate Microeconomics requires A-level equivalent Mathematics as pre-requisite)





## How are modules being allocated to students?

- Students are allocated to the modules on a rule-based priority:
  - Major/minor/seniority/special degree considerations
  - Within the same priority level, allocations will be randomly assigned
  - On a case-by-case basis however, if the module is a gateway or introduction module that will help undeclared majors to explore their interest options, undeclared majors may be prioritized over declared majors who are outside of those modules' affiliated majors

## When will students know the results for each module registration round?

- After each round, Registry will notify students via an email announcement to check the results by logging into OurCORS system

## Module Registration for Semester 2 AY2018/2019 (OurCORS)

---

### **Can I request to take my friend's spot if my friend drops a module?**

- No, students cannot take their friend's spot if friend drops a module due to rule-based prioritization. You will still need to select the module after the vacancy arises in OurCORS system, and your application will be considered alongside other interested students who also selected the module.

### **Can I switch groupings within a module with another student?**

- Yes, you are permitted to swap groups within the same module if you are able to find another student who is willing to do a mutual swap with you. For example, Common Curriculum groupings and groupings within a module.

# Module Registration for Semester 2 AY2018/2019 (OurCORS)

---

## NUS module registration (Optional)

- **Yale-NUS students may cross-register NUS modules:**
  - If you are interested in a particular module not offered within Yale-NUS
  - Recommended by your Faculty Advisor/HOS to take the NUS module

## **2 categories of NUS modules:**

- **NUS CLS modules:** NUS Language modules from Centre for Language Studies (ex: Japanese, Korean, Bahasa Indonesian, etc)
- **NUS elective modules:** Non-language modules from NUS (ex: modules from NUS Business School, Faculty of Arts and Social Science, School of Computing, etc)

## How to register for NUS modules? (Optional)

- NUS modules are not found on ourCORS system as NUS uses a different module registration system and timeline
- NUS modules for Semester 2, AY2018/2019 will be published on 29 November 2018 via NUS CORS Module Info Listing:  
<https://myaces.nus.edu.sg/cors/jsp/report/ModuleInfoListing.jsp>
- In the meantime, you can refer to what NUS modules were offered in previous semesters from NUS Bulletin: <http://www.nus.edu.sg/nusbulletin/search-modules/>
- **Rounds 1 & 2:** Apply via Yale-NUS Canvas online for NUS CLS & NUS Elective modules
- **Round 3:** Complete and submit the Yale-NUS [Module Add/Drop Form](#) to your respective Assistant Dean before the stated deadline for NUS elective modules.  
**\*Note:** Applications for NUS CLS modules is closed for this round.



# Module Registration for Semester 2 AY2018/2019 (OurCORS)

## **Process of NUS module application**

- Registry will collate the information received from Yale-NUS Canvas online and liaise with the respective NUS departments on your module registration
- Registry will email you if we require more information/documents from you
- NUS module will be added to you by the NUS department administrator if application approved

## **When/how will I know the result of the NUS module application?**

- Registry will be notified by NUS and we will email you the outcome of your application approximately 1 week before the start of Semester 2, AY2018/2019
